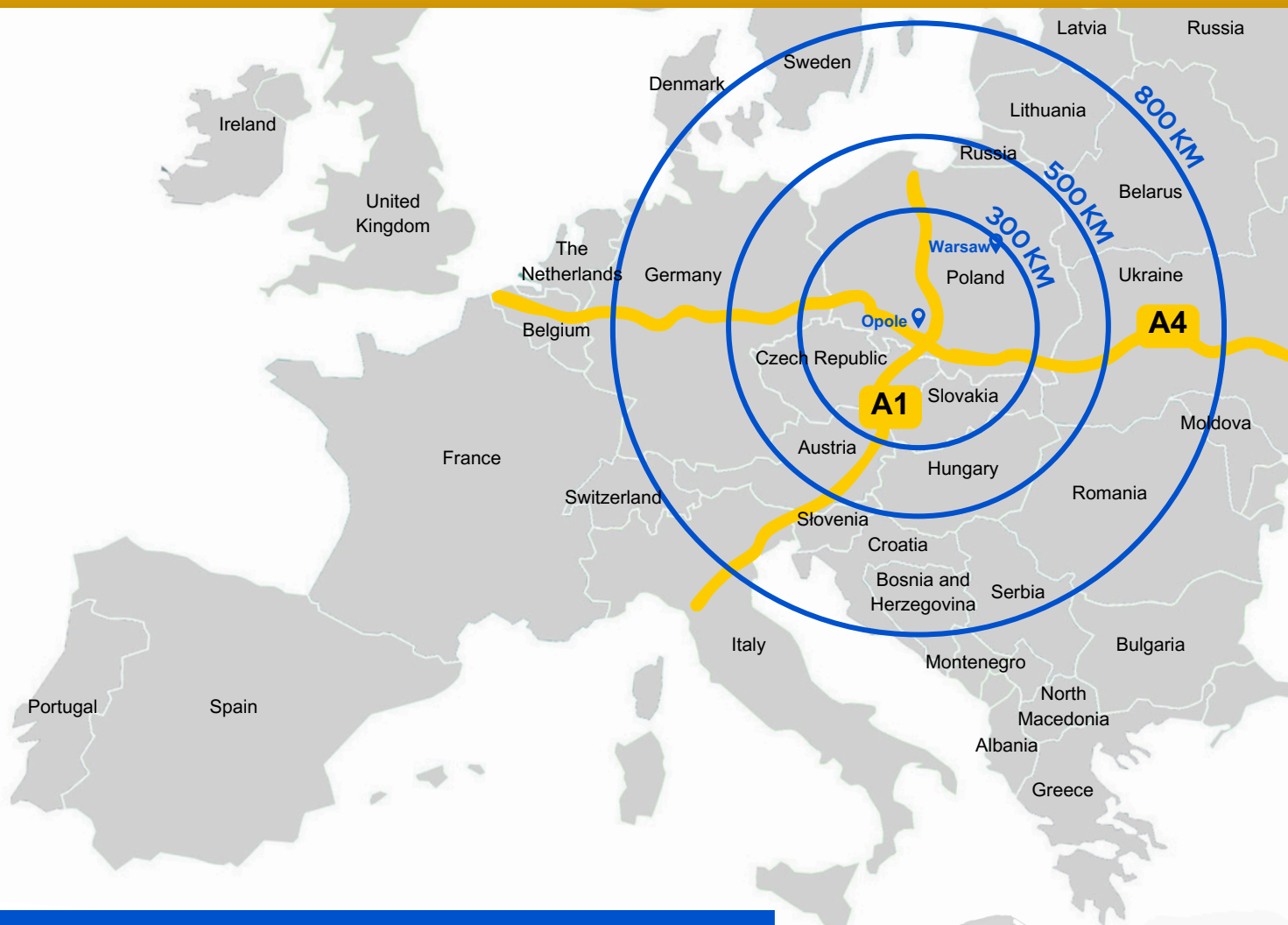

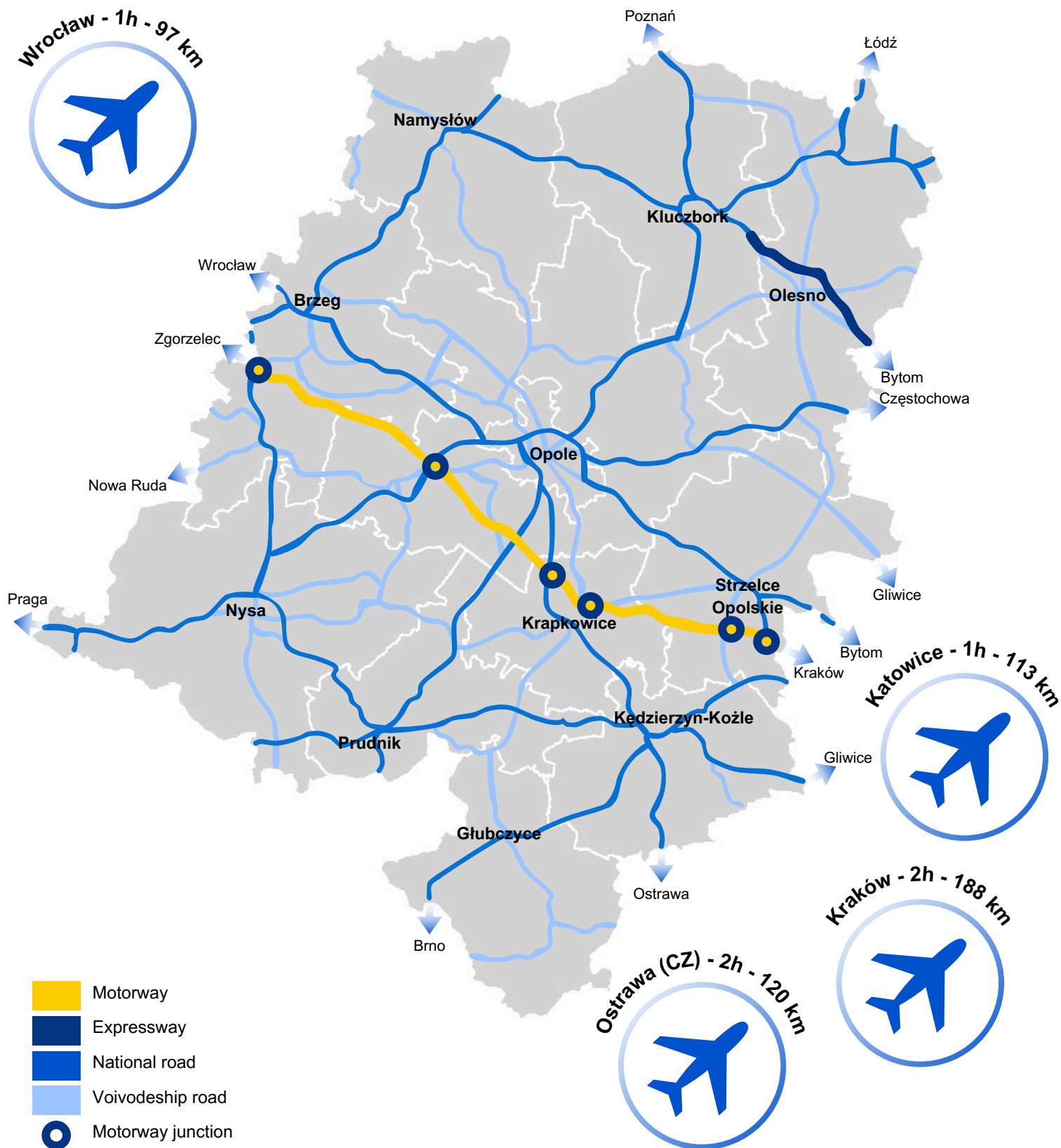

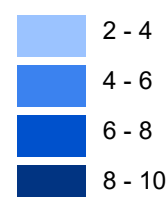
Human Capital

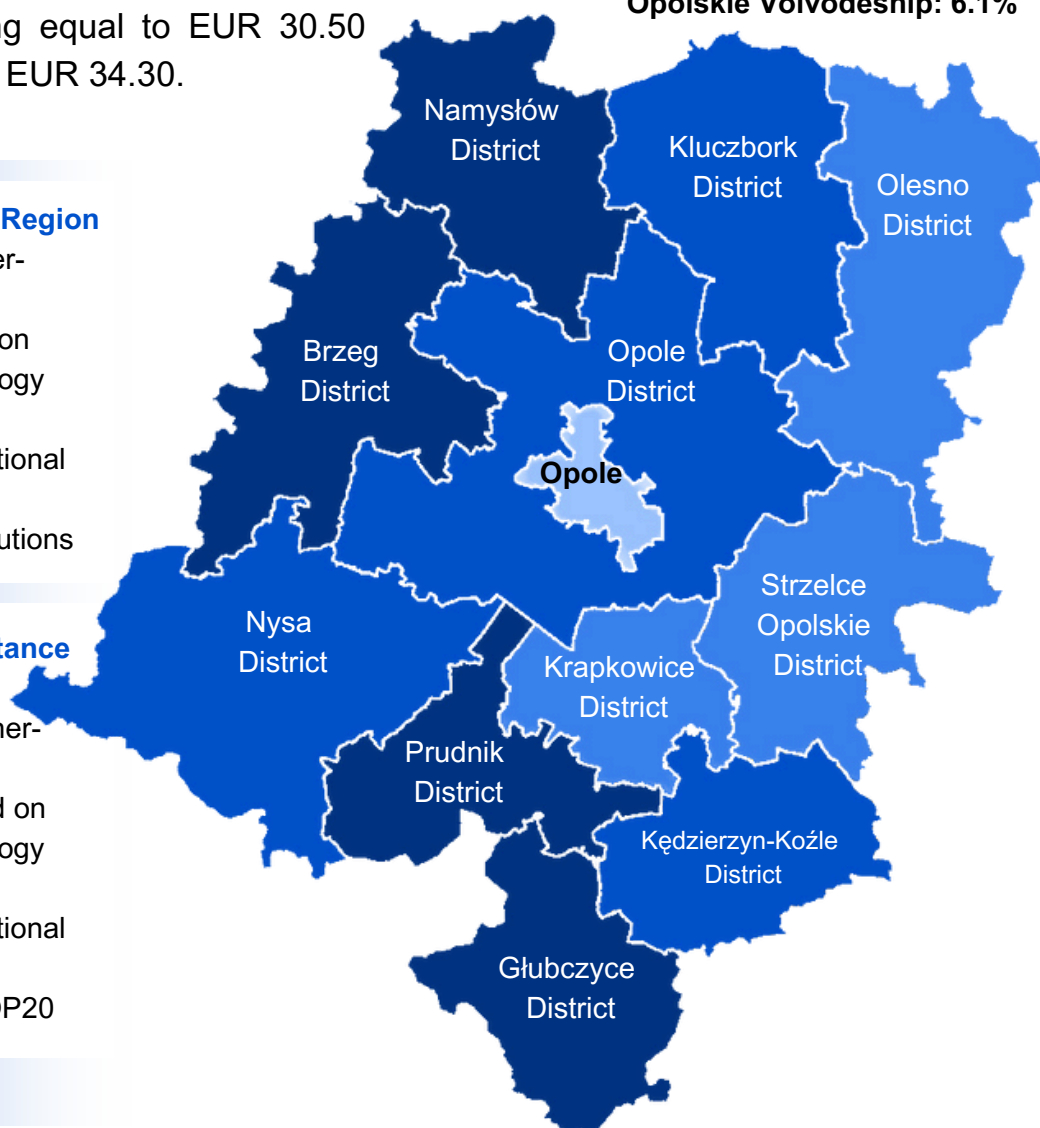

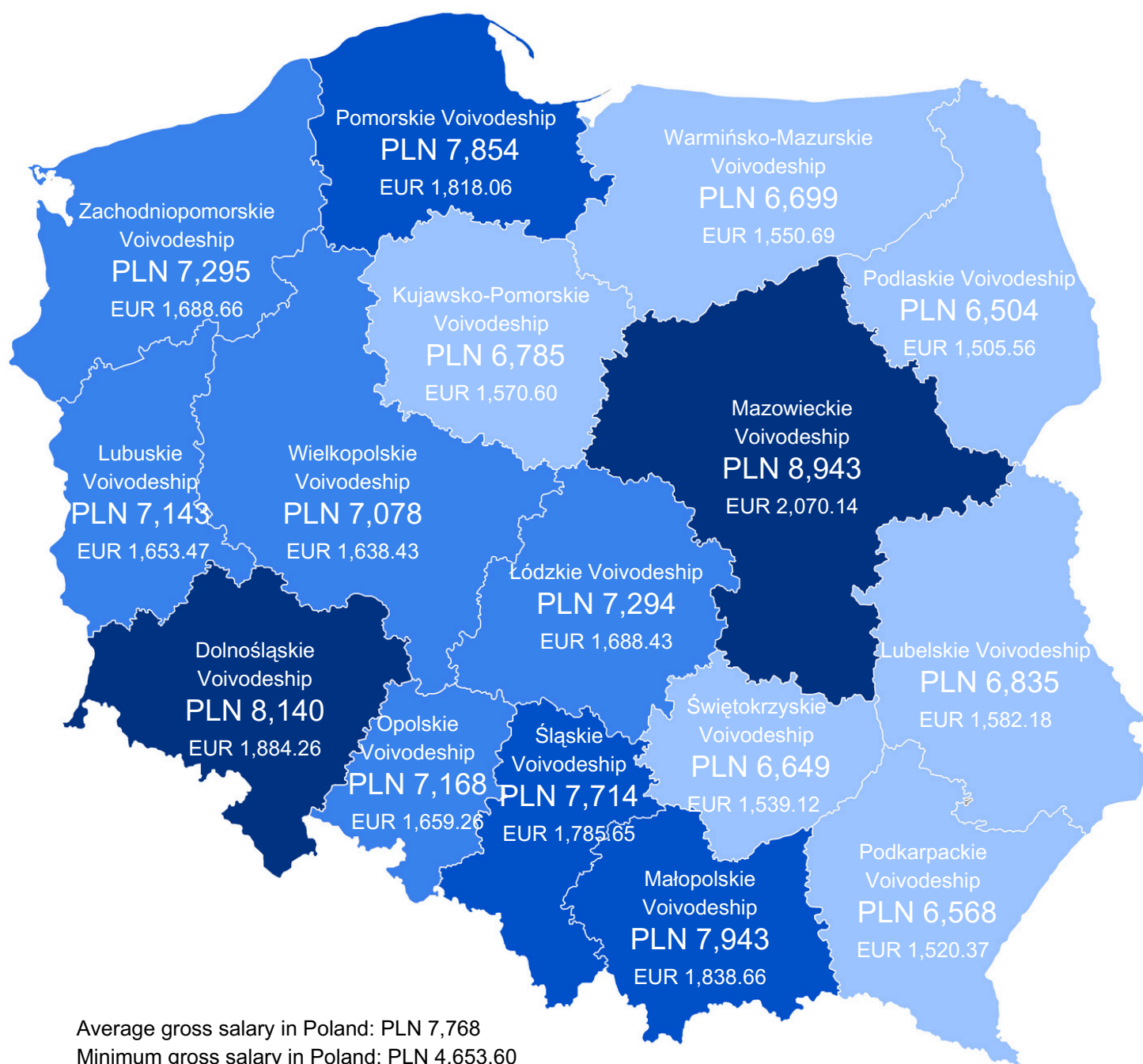

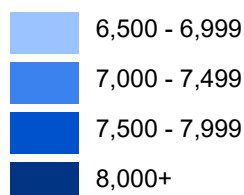

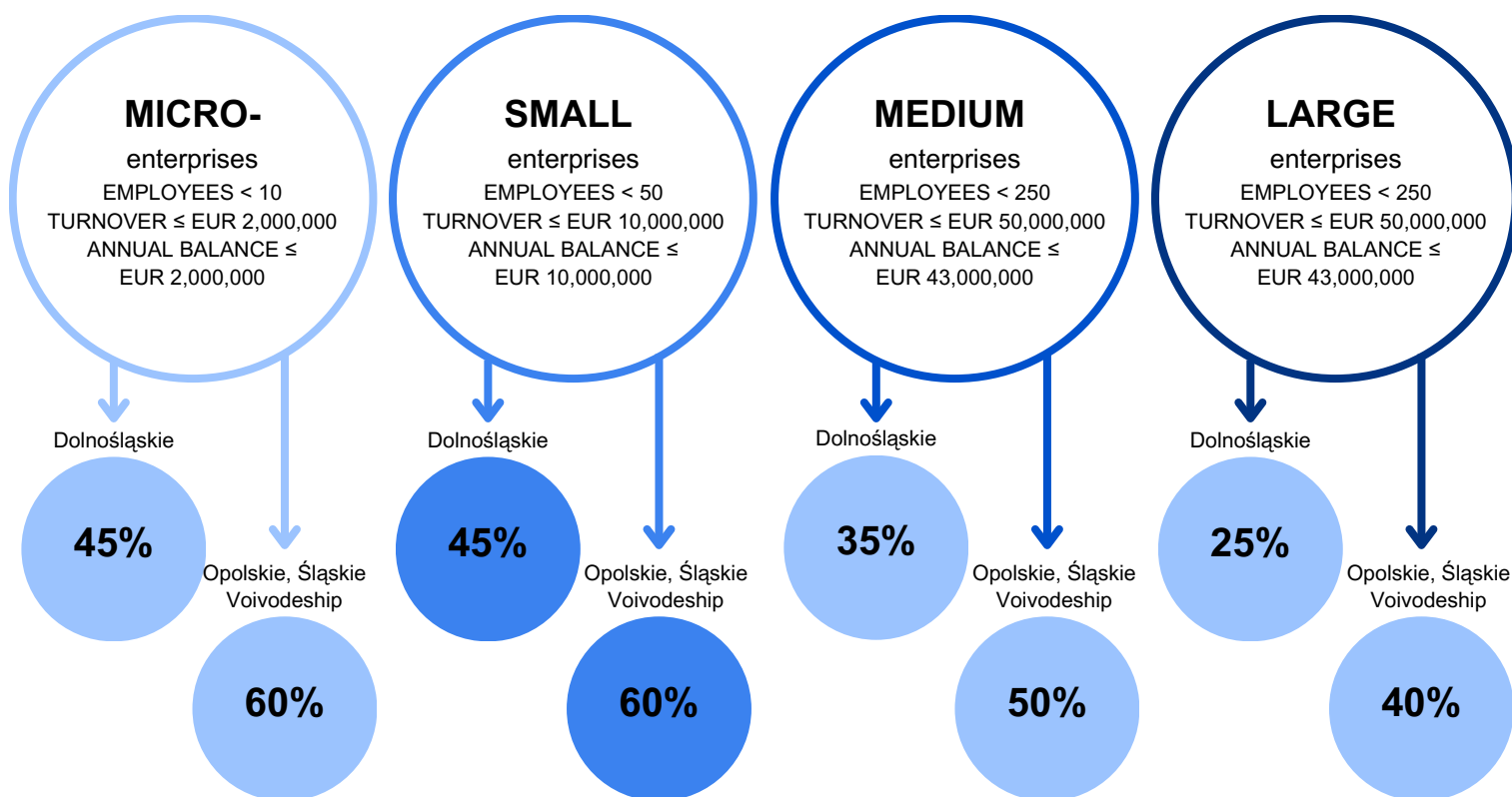

Furniture sector in Opolskie Voivodeship



The furniture industry is an important pillar of Polish exports. In 2017, Polish furniture manufacturers exported goods worth about EUR 11.4 billion, reaching a market share of 9.5% in the furniture market in the European Union. This result allowed Polish companies from the furniture industry to take the 3rd position in terms of the value of furniture produced in the EU. One of the key centers of the domestic furniture industry is the Opolskie Region. The traditions of furniture production in the region are over 200 years old and you can easily find family companies that have been engaged in the production of furniture for several generations.

The small town of Dobrodzień located 45 km from Opole is recognized as the furniture center of the region and is known not only in Poland but also in Europe. Companies such as Kler, Lissy, Mebel Rust, and DES are located here. Dobrodzień is also home to Dobroteka – a showroom, where under one roof brands of local producers are found and research and development activities on interior design are conducted. Dobroteka is a successful example of the cooperation of local furniture producers, contributing to the growth of the potential and recognition of this sector, which is crucial for the Opolskie Region.

The furniture industry has a wide range of research, development, and education facilities. Universities from Opole, Gliwice, and Wrocław provide the industry with a constant supply of qualified engineers, technologists, and designers.

Companies operating in the furniture industry can rely on the help of Opole institutions supporting the business environment. These include the Opole Chamber of Commerce, the Business Centre Club Opole, the Chamber of Crafts in Opole, the “Silesia” Chamber of Commerce, the Science and Technology Park in Opole, the Silesian Development Foundation, Kędzierzyn-Koźle Industrial Park, the Regional Chamber of Commerce in Nysa, the Industrial Park Association Metalchem, and the “Promotion of Entrepreneurship” Association.

The furniture sector in the Opolskie Region can rely on a well-developed railway and road infrastructure, a multitude of local research and education facilities, as well as a convenient geographical location in the middle of Europe, which simplifies the logistics chain and reduces the cost of transporting goods to customers.

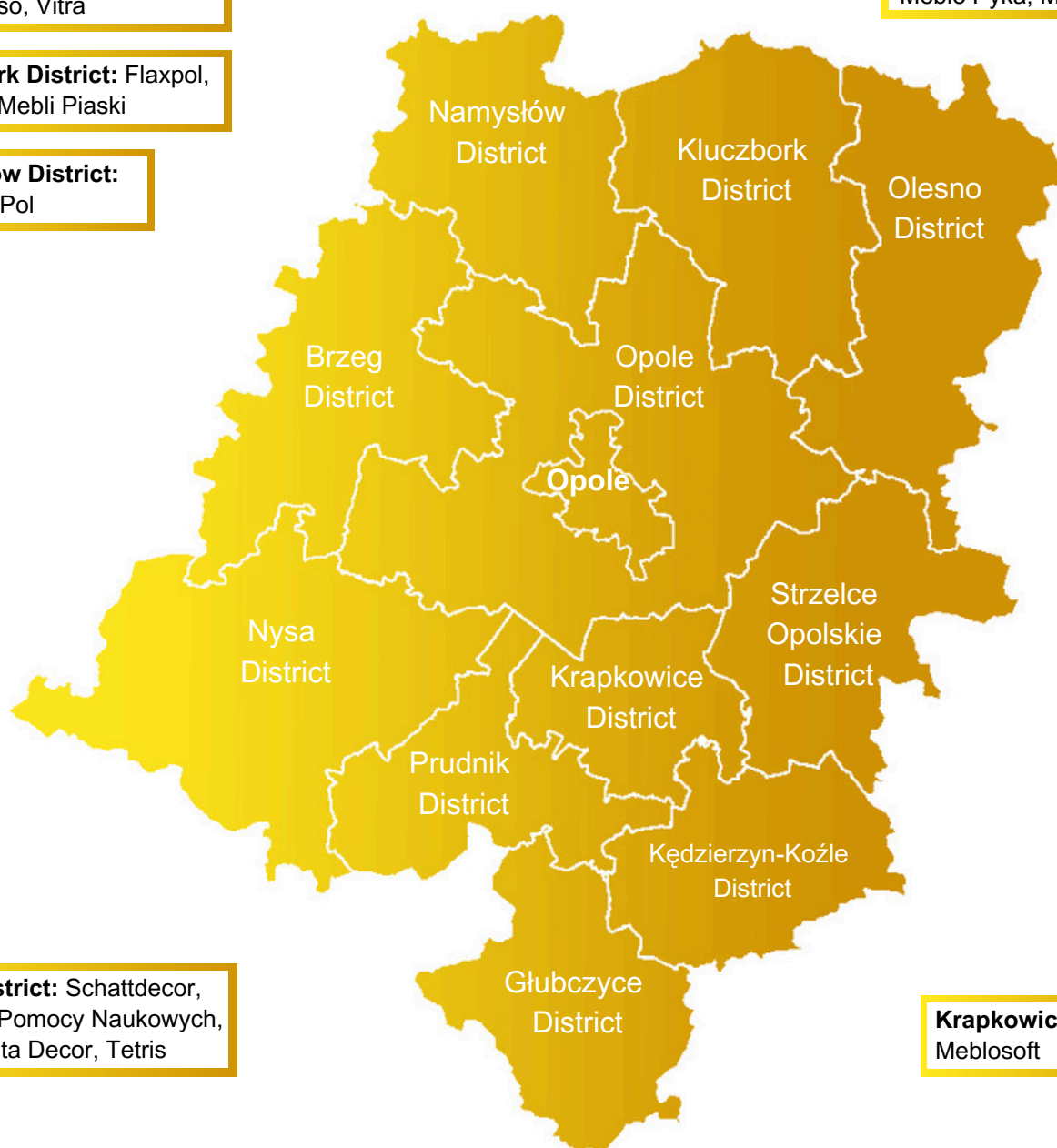

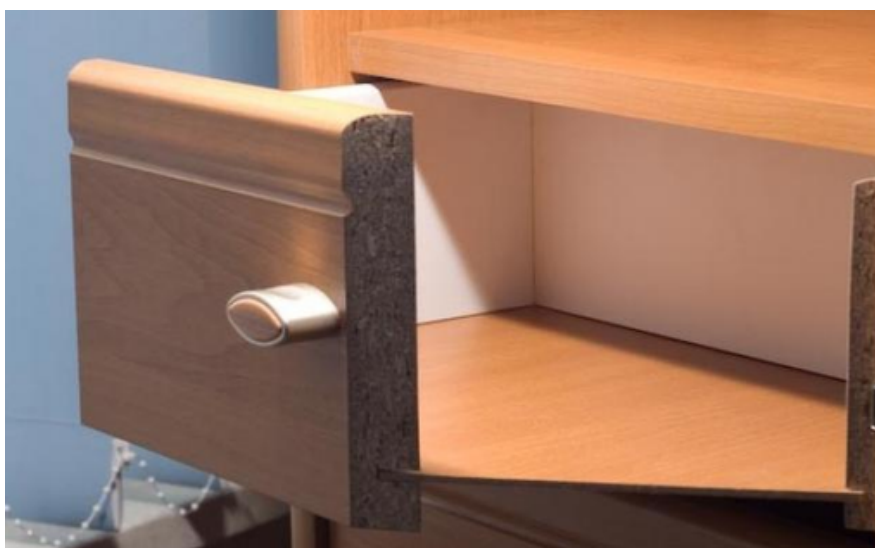

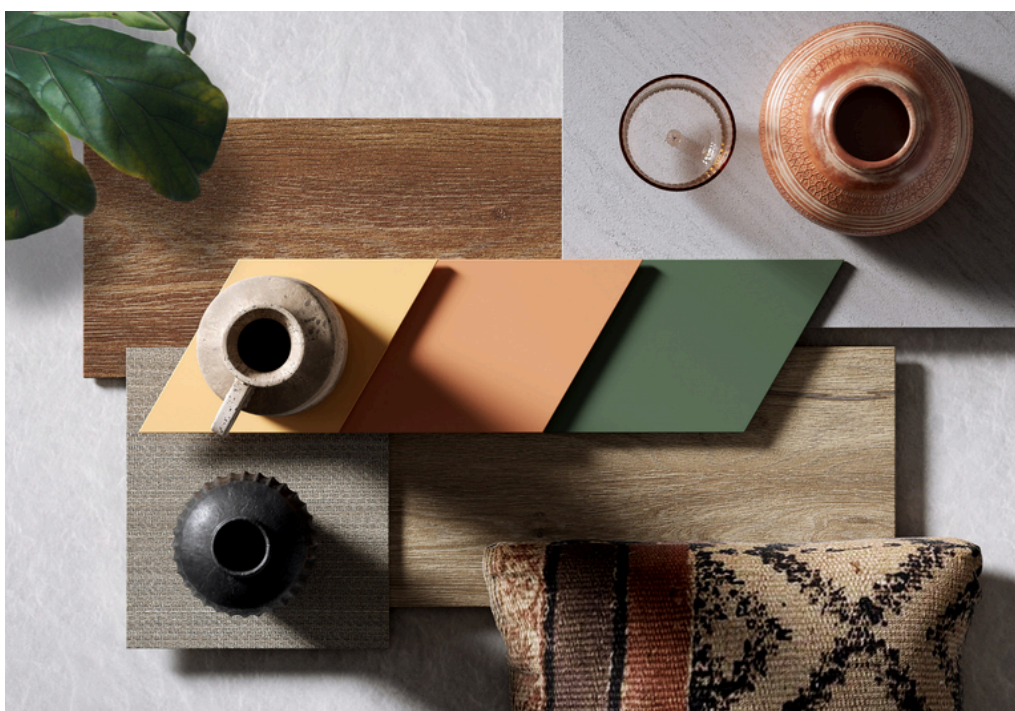
