




Human Capital

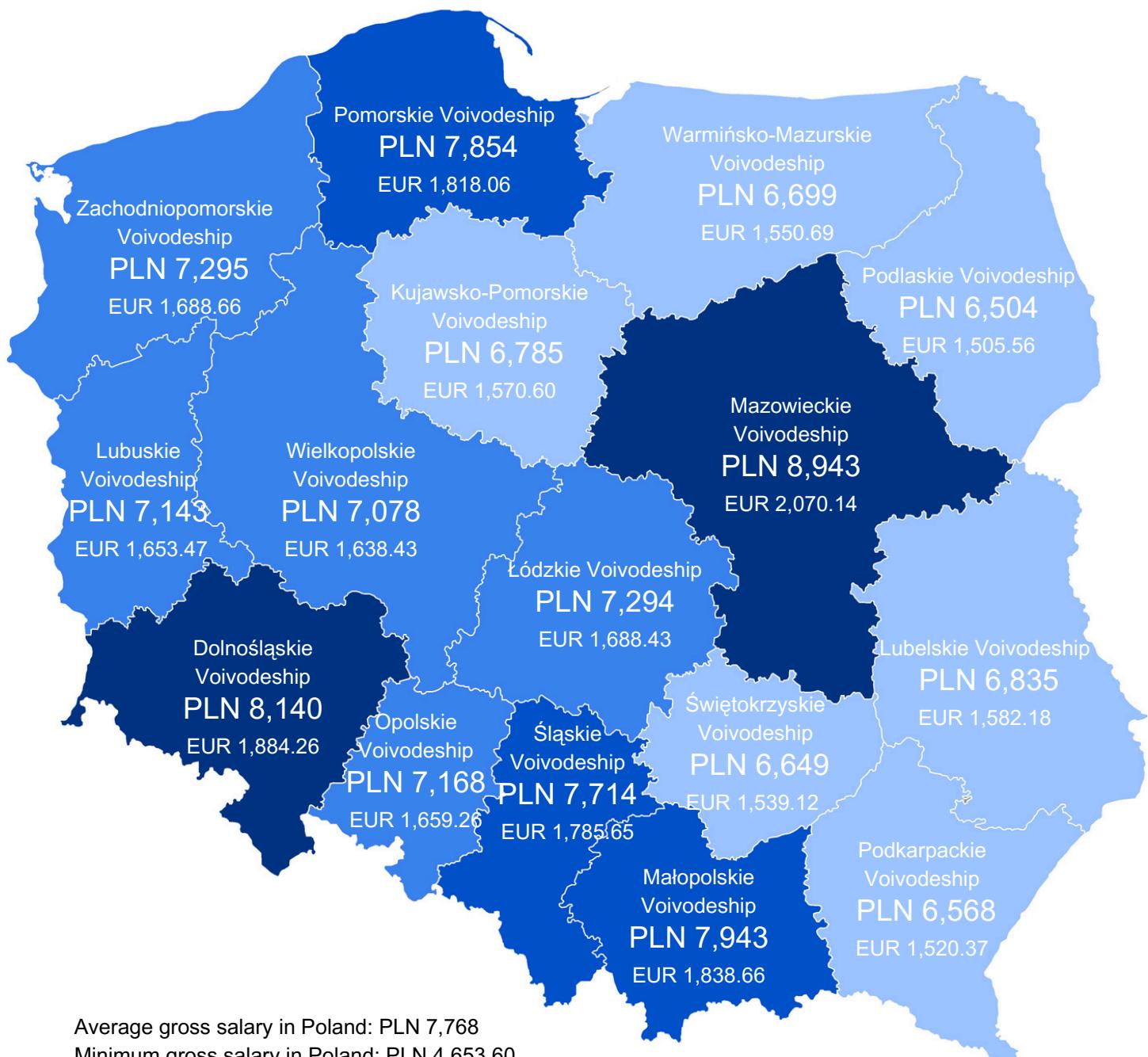





Quantitative criteria

Quantitative criteria

Investment project costs (capital expenditures or two-year labour costs) conditional on:

- An unemployment rate in the district where the site of a new investment project is located (compared to the average unemployment rate in the country);
- The size of an enterprise.

For investments in modern business services and SMEs, the conditions for eligible costs are reduced by:

- 98% (micro-enterprises);
- 95% (small enterprises);
- 80% (medium enterprises);
- 95% (modern services).

Qualitative criteria

In order for a support decision to be issued in the Opolskie Voivodeship a minimum of 5 points must be scored. The maximum number of points = 10.

- Setting up a modern business services centre whose operations extend beyond the territory of Poland;**
- Having the micro-enterprise or SME status.

Sustainable social development (5 points)

- Creating high-paying jobs and offering stable employment;
- Conducting an economic activity that has a low negative impact on the environment;
- Locating an investment project in a city that is losing its social and economic functions or an adjacent commune, or in a district where the unemployment rate is at least 160% of the average unemployment rate in the country (excluding cities which are the seat of a province governor or province assembly);
- Supporting the acquisition of education and professional qualifications and co-operation with sectoral vocational schools;
- Taking actions designed to provide the employee with care.



Food sector in Opolskie Voivodeship



The food-producing industry has a rich tradition in the region. There are many manufacturers of dairy products, meat, cold cuts and sausages, fruit and vegetables, baker's wares and confectionery. The ecologically clean land provides favourable conditions for food crop growing and livestock farming.

The capital structure of the industry is diversified. Here in the Opolskie Region, there are not only companies belonging to international groups, including the largest global concerns, such as Danone, Froneri or Mondelez, but also domestically owned businesses (family-owned butcher's shops, bakeries, or confectionery producers, etc.) A significant number of companies are focused on manufacturing products for export, taking advantage of their proximity to Western European markets.

Among the companies operating in the region, one may find both those that develop own brand production and those that supply products under the private label of retail chains.

Companies trading in the food industry may rely on the assistance of business environment institutions which are based in the Opolskie Region. These include: the Opole Chamber of Commerce, Opole Business Centre Club, the Chamber of Crafts in Opole, the "Silesia" Chamber of Commerce, the Science and Technology Park in Opole, the Silesian Development Foundation, Kędzierzyn-Koźle Industrial Park, the Regional Chamber of Commerce in Nysa, the Metalchem Industrial Park Association, the "Promotion of Entrepreneurship" Association.

The food sector in the Opolskie Region can make use of the very developed road and rail infrastructure, the wide availability of qualified personnel, rich resources, as well as suitable geographical location at the very centre of Europe, which makes the logistical chain simpler and reduces the cost of transporting goods to customers.




